**Invitation to a public exhibition preview of proposals
at land within the Burgess Hill Northern Arc Strategic Site**

As Rydon Homes and Gleeson Strategic Land seek to bring forward proposals to the north of Burgess Hill, known as the 'Northern Arc', I wanted to inform you that a public exhibition will be taking place over two days to provide an update on the progress of the forthcoming applications.

One is Rydon Homes' application for 460 homes with a refurbished play area and public open space at Freeks Farm. The other is Gleeson Strategic Land's separate application area south of the A2300 for 200 homes with a neighbourhood hub and 43,000 sqm of employment floorspace plus a new road link between the A2300 and A273 Jane Murray Way.

As a key stakeholder we are keen to hear your views about the proposals and very much hope you can attend a public exhibition preview, which will be an opportunity to discuss the proposals and for you to ask any questions.
